

1. How did St. Catherine - St. Lucy (SCSL) shape and influence your life? SCSL was the first place where I truly learned the value of friendship and lifelong connections. The friends and peers I made during my time there remain some of my closest relationships to this day, and I credit that entirely to SCSL. My curiosity about people, my desire to truly get to know those I meet, and my drive to network and build meaningful connections are all traits I developed during my time at SCSL. These qualities have become a core part of who I am—and they continue to guide me as I navigate my professional journey.

2. What teacher had the biggest impact on you and why?

This is a difficult question for me because I had so many amazing teachers during my time at SCSL. To me, the word impact means to make a lasting impression—and the teachers who immediately come to mind as "lasting impact" mentors are both Ms. Learny and Ms. Young. Although she'd be the first to admit I was a bit of a troublemaker, Ms. Learny always saw the leader I had the potential to become. She recognized my kind heart and my strong desire to see others succeed. She constantly reminded me how important and necessary people like me are in the world. Ms. Young saw my sense of humor, my love for literature, and the unique perspectives I brought to class. She encouraged me to think outside the box and never silenced my curiosity. She welcomed my questions—especially "why?"—and supported me when I voiced my opinions on things that mattered to me and those around me.

3. What advice would you give a current SCSL 8th grader that is headed to high school next year? Give yourself grace, and remember that adjusting to a new environment, new friends, and a new lifestyle is completely normal. It's okay to feel overwhelmed at times. What's most important is knowing that it's perfectly okay—and even encouraged—to ask for help when you need it. We've all been in your shoes, and we're here with the tools, experience, and support to help you succeed.

4. Why did your parents choose to send you to SCSL?

I grew up just 10 minutes down the street from SCSL in the Austin neighborhood. While there were many schools even closer to home, my parents recognized the value of a private education and the importance of a safe environment. I love my community, but it hasn't always been the safest place. My parents chose SCSL because, from the moment they walked through the doors, they knew my brothers and I would receive a strong education, form lifelong friendships, and be safe.

5. Are there any personal skills or qualities that you developed at SCSL that you still use in your daily life or at your job? I first learned the importance of asking questions and seeking clarity when I was at SCSL. It may seem like a simple lesson, but you'd be surprised how many people in the professional world hesitate to ask for clarification out of fear of appearing incompetent. The truth is, real leaders ask questions—and real leaders would rather you speak up to ensure understanding than stay silent and completely miss the mark.

Being the first in my family to earn a college degree has taught me that there's no single path to success, and that things won't always go according to plan—which is why it's so important not to feel discouraged when they don't. I'm incredibly proud of how far I've come in my journey, and I'm excited for whatever comes next, wherever that may be.










Academic Growth
