- Parent-Teacher Conferences are held after the end of the trimester to discuss student progress. Our goal is to help children grow and achieve at their highest ability. We want to work with parents as our support and ally to make that happen.
- Parents/Guardians of students in Grades K-8 are expected to attend. If for some reason you cannot be here on that day, please contact the classroom teacher to schedule an alternate meeting time.
- Conferences will begin at 1pm and end at 6pm. We have set a time limit of 10 minutes per child.
- Report Cards are distributed during the conference.
- Dismissal is at 11:30am on that day. There will be no lunch and no after-care, but there will be breakfast and morning care.
- Please enter the building through the front doors. Ring the bell to be admitted. Parents with children in Grades K and 1 will also need to ring to gain access to the first floor.
- A selection of winter coats will be out in the front lobby. Please take whatever you need.
- Conferences are held in the classrooms. Grades K-1 are on the first floor; Grades 2-5 are on the second floor; Grades 6-8 and STARS are on the third floor.
 - Kindergarten/1st Grade Parents/Guardians will meet with both Mrs. Lenigan and Mr. Riemma. A sign-up form will go out electronically.
 - o Grade 2 will send a sign-up sheet out electronically.
 - Grades 3-4 will see parents/guardians on a first-come/first-serve basis. Please wait outside the classrooms.
 - o Grade 5 will send out a sign-up sheet electronically.
 - Grades 6-8 will see parents on a first-come/first-serve basis. Parents may meet individually with all the junior high teachers. Please wait outside the classrooms.
 - o STARS Teachers will be available to meet with parents/guardians if needed.
 - o Mrs. Cooper is staffing the main office during that time.
